Census Explained

The State of Ohio is partnering with the U.S. Census Bureau to organize and implement the decennial census advocacy and promotional campaign. Working together, Ohio's goal will be to have a complete count of Ohio residents on April 1, 2010. The Department of Development has been designated as Governor Strickland's Census Liaison agency to the Census Bureau.

American Community Survey (ACS)

The American Community Survey, sometimes referred to as the ACS, is a continuous nationwide survey that collects essentially the same information on people and housing that was collected on the long-form questionnaire used in Census 2000. Each month a sample of housing unit addresses receives a questionnaire. Approximately three million addresses are surveyed each year.

Why fill out the census form?

It's Important! - Census data affects funding for your community, your Congressional representative and your community leaders.

It's easy! - The census questionnaire takes only a few minutes to answer and return by mail.

It's confidential! - Your responses are protected by law (Title 13, U.S. Code, Section 9). All Census Bureau employees have taken an oath to protect confidentiality and are subject to a jail term, a fine—or both—for disclosing any information that could identify a respondent or household.

It's required by law! - The information you provide is combined with responses provided by your neighbors and other households across the county, to provide summary statistical data that is used by various, local, state and federal agencies.

Subcommittees and their role

The Licking County Complete Count Committee has formed 5 subcommittees. Local Government, Education, Faith-Based/Community, Media/ Recruiting and Business.

Local Government Subcommittee - assists in all activities between the Census Bureau and the local government, such as participation in decennial geography programs, free space for Questionnaire Assistance centers and identifying other resources for CCC activities.

Education Subcommittee - facilitates census awareness for local schools from pre-k through 12th grade, as well as postsecondary education institutions in the area. May also encourage school administrators, teachers, and students to use the Census in school materials.

Faith-Based/Community Subcommittee - creates and coordinates activities and materials that can be used by any local faith-based institution in the promotion of the 2010 Census awareness and participation. Also collaborates with community organizations to inform residents of the importance of participating in the 2010 Census and the benefits derived from census data.

Media/Recruiting Subcommittee - creates and facilitates ways to get the census message to all community residents, using all available sources such as local newspapers, newsletters, fliers, local festivities, billboards, radio and television. Disseminates information about census job openings for the 2010 Census. Information will include the number of jobs available, types of job available, and the locations of testing and training sites.

Business Subcommittee - creates and coordinates activities that involve businesses in census awareness, such as distribution of census information and census messages on packaging (grocery bags), and in the inclusion of the census logo and message on sales promotion materials.
